

VILLAGE OF NEW LEXINGTON COUNCIL MEETING
January 21, 2014
MUNCIPAL BUILDING

The Village of New Lexington met in regular session with Mayor Eveland presiding. Council Members present were Trent Thompson, Richard Anderson, Jeff Danison, Kathy Chute, Polly Pletcher, Al Vandewater and Tim Fiore. Also present were Village Administrator Scott Bryant, Police Chief Scott Ervin and Finance Director Heather Rockwell.

Councilperson Pletcher made a motion to approve the minutes as read. Seconded by Councilperson Thompson. All Council voted "yes" except for Councilperson Vandewater who abstained due to being absent at the last meeting. Motion carried.

Mayor Eveland stated that the Street Department has been doing a great job during all the inclement weather.

Finance Director Rockwell gave a power point presentation showing revenues and expenses for Fire/EMS and General Fund. Finance Director Rockwell stated that all departments have made cuts to their budgets. She also stated that we need to find ways to increase Village revenue.
