

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE 77-9 AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Village of New Lexington has determined a need for changes in credit for tax paid to other municipalities.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of New Lexington, Perry County, Ohio as follows:

Section 1: That effective for the tax year 2014 and thereafter, Section 8 of Ordinance Number 77-9 passed November 7, 1977, is hereby amended and adopted in full as follows:

Section 8: RECIPROCITY PROVISION- CREDIT FOR TAX PAID TO ANOTHER MUNICIPALITY.

No credit for income tax payable to another municipality shall be permitted as an offset to municipal income tax due the Village of New Lexington.


Section 2: Except for the changes noted above, Ordinance 77-9, 77-10 and 95-34 shall remain in effect.

Section 3: That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the inhabitants of the Village of New Lexington, and shall take effect January 1, 2014 or at the earliest date provided by law. Ordinance 2003-21 is hereby repealed.


