

RESOLUTION NO. 14- 14

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE FINANCE DIRECTOR TO IMPLEMENT THE COST ALLOCATION PLAN PREPARED BY MAXIMUS CONSULTING SERVICES AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Village of New Lexington, Ohio contracted with Maximus Consulting Service, Inc. to prepare a Cost Allocation Plan based on 2012 year-end financial information

WHEREAS, the Village of New Lexington deems it necessary to implement recommendations from the final draft of the Cost Allocation Plan

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Village Council of the Village of New Lexington, Perry County, Ohio:

Section 1: That the Finance Director shall use the *2012 Based Cost Allocation Plan* for the allocation of future Village expenses where appropriate.

Section 2: That the attachment marked "Exhibit A" is hereby incorporated into the Finance Director's methods of paying Village expenses effective August 19, 2014.

Section 3: That any and all resolutions and ordinances inconsistent with this resolution are hereby repealed to the extent to which they are inconsistent with this resolution.

Section 4: That this Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety and the welfare of the residents of the Village of New Lexington and shall, therefore, go into immediate effect provided it receives a two-thirds (2/3) vote of all members elected to this Council; otherwise, it shall go into effect in thirty (30) days if passed by a majority vote of Council.
