A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE FINANCE DIRECTOR TO REQUEST APPROVAL FROM THE AUDITOR OF THE STATE OF OHIO TO ESTABLISH A SIDEWALK IMPROVEMENT FUND AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Village Council of the Village of New Lexington, Perry County, Ohio:

Section 1: That the Village of New Lexington hereby requests authorization from the Auditor of the State of Ohio to establish within the budgetary accounts of the Village of New Lexington, a special revenue fund to be titled "Sidewalk Improvement Fund", with said fund to be used for the receipt and dispersal of all monies remaining from the grant obtained by the Perry County Health Department resulting from the Village of New Lexington Broadway Walkability Project and monies received from residents for sidewalk improvements.

Section 2: This fund would be established for the sole purpose of receipt and disbursement of sidewalk monies received from the Perry County Health Department and payments from residents of New Lexington for sidewalk improvements.

Section 3: That this resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the inhabitants of the Village of New Lexington, and shall take effect immediately upon passage or at the earliest period allowed by law.
